

Please find below some important information about the event and for your safety.

Sunlight Colourthon

Please arrive for the start in Chalkwell Park (at the junction of London Road and Chalkwell Avenue) from 2:30pm for registration. The walk will run between 3 and 5pm with the challenge being to complete as many laps as you possibly can.

Moonlight Colourthon

Please arrive for the start in Chalkwell Park (at the junction of London Road and Chalkwell Avenue) from 6pm for registration. A pre-walk warm up session will be held around 7.30pm with the main walk commencing at 8pm.

There are NO parking facilities within Chalkwell Park. FREE Event Parking has been provided by 'c2c' at Leigh-on-Sea Railway Station and Arriva have provided a courtesy shuttle bus to transfer you to and from the start/finish. The shuttle buses will start from 6pm with the last bus returning to Leigh Station at 2am Sunday morning. No other transport will be arranged by us after this time.

Water stops and toilet facilities will be signposted throughout the route as will notices of any hazards. NO storage facilities for personal effects will be available at the venue. Event Stewards will be able to advise you of water stops, toilet facilities, etc. on route.

Don't forget, dress as brightly as possible, you can wear whatever you want to compliment your 'Colourthon' T-Shirt: hats, flags, flashing lights the brighter the better! At the end of the walk you will receive an exclusive Colourthon medal, providing you are displaying your walking number!

Please carry a mobile phone for your safety, our **EMERGENCY NUMBER** is **07014 212570**, please save this in your mobile phone.

Ahead of the event it's important that you fully complete the I.C.E. information on the reverse of your walking number. Please also complete the amount you have pledged to raise in the space provided on the front of your walker's number.

You are advised to walk in pairs or groups at all times for your protection and safety. Stewards will be at most junctions and throughout the route, local Police will also be at certain junctions; please listen to them and remember that everyone involved with the event including the Stewards have given their time on a totally voluntary basis to ensure your enjoyment and safety.

St. John Ambulance will be available throughout the event, if you need assistance please call our EMERGENCY NUMBER. Should you require hospital treatment or decide to leave the walk PLEASE LET US KNOW.

Remember that you are walking as part of a large group on a public footway and respect should be shown to other users and local residents throughout the duration of the event.

Please adhere to the 'Rules and Conditions' of entry to this event. No alcohol is allowed in the park or during the event and if you have any concerns please speak to a Route Steward.
